Household Inventory

Now is the time to prepare your household inventory. It will help you and your insurance adjuster establish loss payments in the event of a claim. It will also help confirm that you are adequately covered.

Engraving is a valuable aid for you and the police to identify your possessions if they are unfortunately stolen. See [www.operationident.pdf](#)

Here's how to prepare your inventory...

1. Create a separate list for each of these categories or use this [Inventory List.pdf](#)

	furniture and appliances, listed room by room	
	Clothing, listed for each person	
	Jewelry, silverware and other valuables	
	Computer equipment and software	
	Books, tools, bicycles, and other items	
	Credit cards, and who to notify if they are lost or stolen	

2. Don't forget to list all items in your basement, garage and yard
3. Keep the sales receipts for all major purchases. Keep your receipts at a different location such as a safety deposit box.
4. Update the lists as you purchase new items or dispose of old items
5. Keep a copy of the inventory in a safe place , like a safety deposit box, don't store on your computer (if your computer is stolen so is your inventory)
6. Review your inventory annually, preferable 30-60 days before your insurance renewal.

OR

1. Take pictures.
2. Video tape your belongings.
