C - Jim D. – notices a lot of cars around with a burned out headlight are they charged or do they get a warning? They do get a first chance warning but will be charged the second time they are seen.

If a person is in an accident in a vehicle with worn tires can they get charged? Yes they can be charged for an unfit vehicle.

D - Pat B. Is it an offence to have faded, dirty, or obscured plates on a car ? Yes it is a minimum \$105.00 fine, and you can not repaint your plates because that is considered an alteration which is an offence.

E - Peter G.- If a person has a classic car with a 6 volt electrical system and they are using blue dot tail lights are these lights illegal? These dots are meant to accelerate the smaller dull lights of these early cars so they can be seen better in today's traffic.

These lights could cause some confusion with emergency vehicles. A blue light on a vehicle is supposed to represent a snow removal or emergency vehicle only. A safety check is only to ensure the integrity of the vehicle such things as window tint and blue dot tail lights will satisfy a mechanic but still be an infraction of DOT standards.

Constable Gagne will check the regulations to be sure.
