#### 6. NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

7. **New Business:**  
A - The bike rodeo – we received a thank you letter from the Masonic Lodge

**F** - There are tree branches obstructing motorist's views at the corners of Vroom and Paget Street and Albert and Paget Street. These should be trimmed back to improve safety.

**G** - Ross Helps made a motion that Ron gets a reimbursement for his printing supplies, seconded by Kevin J - **CARRIED**

**A** - Ross Helps. – Has lived in Corunna for a long time and notices that some stop signs are not working and that speeding on Hill street makes it dangerous to maneuver from side streets. ## **STATS JUNE, JULY, & AUGUST 2011**

### **JUNE 2011**

- Calls for service 149 vs 130 for May and 148 for June 2010

#### **Areas of Note**

- 2 B & E incidents
- 5 mischief incidents
- 10 motor Vehicle accidents
- 6 of the 7 Liquor Licence Act incidents were during the Annual Corunna Firefighters Association Field Days.
- Of the 4 warrants for arrest 3 were drug related (all 3 charged) and the other was for a wanted person who was taken in to custody.
- Of the 3 reported assaults 2 arrests were made and in the third the complainant declined to lay charges. 1 reported sexual assault was determined to be unfounded.

### **JULY 2011**

- Calls for service 142 vs 149 for June 2011 and 137 for July 2010

#### **Areas of Note:**

- 1 B & E incident
- 16 thefts during July – 12 from vehicles overnight and 3 thefts of lawn ornaments
- 13 Trouble With Youth incidents vs 6 reported in June
- 5 motor vehicle accidents
- 13 Liquor Licence Act incidents – 5 were during the Captain Kidd Days weekend
- 3 assaults reported – 1 was determined to be unfounded, 1 lead to charges to be laid, and in the other the complainant declined to lay charges.

### **AUGUST 2011**

- Calls for service 149 vs 142 for July 2011 and 107 for August 2010

#### **Areas of Note**

- 1 B & E incident
- 14 thefts from vehicles overnight
- 5 Trouble With youth incidents
- 4 motor vehicle accidents
- 3 mischief incidents – 2 of which were vehicles entered overnight with no thefts from the vehicle
- ZERO Liquor Licence Act incidents
- ZERO Impaired Drivers
- 4 reported drug offences
- 1 reported assault – party arrested for domestic
