## Police Authorization to Enter Dwelling

**It is understood that:**

**I have discussed this form with child/youth.**

- This authority will only be acted upon in circumstances where the Police is in receipt of a call for service or, where by any other medium it has come to the attention of the Police that the apparent conduct of one or more persons, on or in relation to the said residence, would reasonably warrant police intervention;
- This authorization is not intended nor will it be construed to be a request for property checks or to provide house sitting services;
- This authorization will not and does not obligate or hold the Police liable for any tort, damage, injury, act against parliament or other wrongdoing occurring directly or indirectly on or in relation to any person(s) or the said residence;

- The express permission granted by virtue of this authorization is consistent with the requirements of the Trespass To Property Act (R.S.O. 1990 c. T.21) recognizing the Police and its members as an "agent" of the occupier;
- It will be the sole responsibility of the occupier to apprise all other persons of this authorization who will, or who might reasonably expect to, occupy the premises during the authorized period;
- The occupier can at any time during the authorized period withdraw his or her authorization – a request to withdraw such authorization, prior to the expiration of the original term, will require the occupier to appear in person at the police station.
