### How Watches Function

The most important thing to remember:  
communicate!

Look out for your neighbours and keep in touch  
with one another.

If you see anything suspicious, call the Police!

If you are a victim of a crime:  
**call the Police first** and then inform your Area  
Coordinator, a Committee Member or your  
Captain/Co-Captain.

#### Area Coordinator:

- starts the communication link if they hear of activity from anyone in the neighbourhood or the Watch office
- notifies the Watch office of any activity



#### Committee:

- help to relay information to the Area Coordinator and/or the Captains and Co-Captains (zone contacts).
- works with the Watch office when needed



#### Zone Contacts:

- act as the contacts for each zone
- relay information to their neighbours about activity in their zone
- inform the Area Coordinator or a Committee member about activity in their zone



#### All Neighbours:

- look out for your neighbours
- contact the Area Coordinator, a Committee Member or the Captain or Co-Captain about any activity
