HOW TO REDUCE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR CRIME

- 1) TAKE STEPS TO MAKE YOUR HOME APPEAR THAT IT IS OCCUPIED
 - Turn on TV, radio, lights, etc.
- 2) SECURE WINDOWS AND DOORS
 - Consider installing locks on windows, security bars, etc. - Install double cylinder deadbolt locks on doors
 - Replace striker plates and screws on exterior doors (7cm.- 3 inch - screws will secure the striker plate to the door jam and house frame)
- 3) KEEP GARAGE DOOR CLOSED AND SECURE AT ALL TIMES.
- 4) CHANGE AUTOMATIC GARAGE DOOR REMOTE FROM FACTORY SETTING
- 5) UNPLUG YOUR GARAGE DOOR OPENER WHEN YOU ARE AWAY FOR ANY EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME.
- 6) PUT LIGHTS ON TIMERS OR SENSORS
- 7) PROTECTIVE FILM CAN BE PLACED ON WINDOWS TO PREVENT THEM FROM EASILY BEING SHATTERED
- 8) INSTALL and USE A HOME ALARM SYSTEM
- 9) CANCEL NEWSPAPERS, ARRANGE TO HAVE MAIL AND/OR FLYERS PICKED UP. 10) STORE VALUABLES IN A UNIQUE LOCATION.
- 11) CONSIDER BOLTING DOWN VCR AND STEREO IN THEIR CABINETS.
- 12) OPERATION IDENTIFICATION:
 - Engrave identifiable number on valuables (not S.L.N. number)
 - Engravers can be obtained through the local O.P.P. office
 - Replace striker plates and screws
- 13) IMMEDIATELY REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS PERSONS OR VEHICLES TO POLICE.

How Do We Make Neighbourhood Watch Work?

AREA COORDINATOR

- Starts the communication link if they hear of activity from anyone in the neighbourhood or from Corunna Neighbourhood Watch
- Notifies the Watch contact of any neighbourhood activity



ZONE CONTACTS

- Act as the contact for neighbours in each zone
- Inform the Area Coordinator or a committee member of activity in their area.



ALL NEIGHBOURS:

- Look out for your neighbours
- Contact your Area Coordinator
